RAIDERS IN ACTION

Honoring Students for Making a Difference in Our Community

Raiders in Action is a CRHS PTSA-sponsored service program that recognizes and rewards students for volunteering in the community. All students are encouraged to join CRHS PTSA and participate in Raiders in Action.

Mission: To raise awareness of the community's needs, encourage student service, and provide information to students who wish to serve as volunteers in Round Rock and the surrounding areas.

Vision: To have every student volunteer with non-profit organizations.

Goal: For students to give back to their community, learn they can be responsible for making great things happen, and that the time they spend can impact and make a difference.

Recognition: Students who complete 80 hours of service, an average of 20 hours per year, will be recognized with a silver Community Service Cord at graduation.

In order for community service hours to be counted toward Raiders in Action, students must:

• Perform work for a non-profit organization.

- Complete the work without compensation or class credit.
- Complete the Service Verification Form and have it signed by the supervising adult that is not a family member.
- Hours are accepted in 15-minute increments. (15 min = .25, 30 min = .5, or 45 min = .75)
- Hours are to be submitted by July 10 for the Spring semester, September 10 for Summer hours, and January 10 for the Fall semester.
 - **SENIORS** must turn in all hours by April 1, of their graduating year, to qualify for the Community Service graduation cord.
 - Freshmen / New Students: You can start receiving hours on June 1 of your Freshman year of High School.

Important Notes:

- All paperwork needs to be filled in with blue or black ink

- Please label files as: Graduation Year Name of Student ID # RIA (for verification forms), Contract, Receipt, or Event Name (for photo)
 * e.g. 2026 AmandaAyres 112277 RIA, 2026 AmandaAyres 112277 Contract, 2026 AmandaAyres 112277 Receipt, or 2026 AmandaAyres 112277 ShoeDrive
- Any illegible/incomplete submissions may be requested to be resubmitted.
- Receipts must be submitted with monetary donations and a photo for each activity. *A selfie with either the item or doing the project.
- Fundraising efforts that benefit community service and programs qualify for service hours. However, fundraising activities that directly benefit you or an organization you belong to will not qualify.

 (e.g. a bake sale to raise money for the animal shelter counts but a catalog sale to raise funds for the orchestra does not)
- Hours that you earn for youth organizations or 501c3 are eligible to count towards Raiders in Action hours if the Raiders in Action Community Service Verification Form is completed.
- Students may not count hours worked for CRHS student organizations or athletic programs where they are a member. Students
 are expected to contribute time to the activities they choose to participate in. If the student potentially benefits from the service
 OR if it is required/expected as part of the program, then the hours do not count toward Raider in Action hours.
 *There are some expectations at the discretion of the PTSA board.
- Students should keep a copy of their Raiders in Action Community Service Verification forms for their records.
- Volunteer hours can be recorded for a job, college, and scholarship applications.
- Volunteer opportunities may be posted on the PTSA website and social media as needed.
- Hours will be posted on the PTSA website at the beginning of each month and students are responsible for verifying their hours.
- Students are representing CRHS and should wear CRHS spirit wear or colors when possible.
